Haemoglobinopathy

A haemoglobinopathy is a genetic disorder of the red blood cells. The red blood cells contain a substance called haemoglobin and its function is to carry oxygen around the body.

There are a number of patients registered at this hospital with a red cell disorder or Haemoglobinopathy.

Most of the patients have Sickle Cell disease and a small number have Thalassaemia or less common haemoglobinopathies.

Phlebotomy services are available for outpatients Monday to Friday 8.30am-4.30pm. The phlebotomy department is closed at weekends and bank holidays.

Transfusion/red cell exchange appointments are conducted on Ward 1A (Haematology Day Ward). Day Ward opening times are Monday-Friday 9am-5pm by appointment only.

Appointments with the Haematology Psychology team can be made via referral from the Haemoglobinopathy team to the psychology service.

Inpatient services are offered on Ward 8B. Visiting hours for Ward 8B are 2pm-7pm. A maximum of two visitors are allowed at the bedside at any one time.

In an emergency, patients should attend the Accident and Emergency Department at the Royal Liverpool Hospital.
